Fighting cancer for rural women

Team CSR of Ambuja Neotia, in collaboration with Chittaranjan National Cancer Institute (CNCI), recently conducted a comprehensive cancer awareness and screening camp in Punya village, near Raichak, reaching out to 70 rural women. The initiative focused on both preventive and curative measures, including awareness sessions through audio-visual aids, oncologist consultations, instant mammography, and cervical screening – all conducted on the same day.

A mobile integrated mammography clinic from CNCI facilitated mammography tests, while Dr. Manisha Vernekar, a renowned oncologist, led the awareness sessions and provided consultations. As a gesture of care, all participating women received a hygiene kit containing sanitary napkins, fruit, and other essentials, packaged in handmade paper bags.

The most impactful aspect of this initiative is its long-term support — any woman diagnosed with cancer through this camp will receive free treatment at CNCI hospitals in Kolkata, covering chemotherapy, radiation, or surgery. Given that cervical and breast cancers are among the leading causes of death in women today, this camp provided life-saving interventions. Encouraged by its success, the programme is set to be replicated in other villages in the near future.
